GARDEN TERMS TO KNOW—

Annuals: Plants that complete their life cycle in one year. Annuals must be replaced each year. Valued for providing lots of color over a long season.

Perennials: Plants that return year after year in the garden; typically flower for shorter durations. Valued for reliability, longevity, structure.

Divine Classics: Unusual annuals that grow larger and taller; typically, excellent cut flowers.

Edibles: Fruits, vegetables & herbs, including unusual varieties, heirlooms and standard-bearers.

EXPOSURE: -

Full Sun: 8+ hours of direct sunlight per day
Part Sun: 3-6 hours of direct sunlight per day

Part Shade: Less than 3 hours direct sun per day (refers to amount of time, not quality of light)

Full Shade: Minimal or no direct sun

Bright light / Indirect light: No direct sun, but plen-

ty of bright sunlight

Dappled sun: Sunlight is filtered through leaves of

nearby trees & plants

Overcast: No direct sun; foggy; mid-level light

PLANT THEMES: -

DEER-RESISTANT: Indicates plants have some level of deer-resistance, including:

- Deer-tolerant: May be nibbled by browsing deer, but will survive
- · Deer-resistant: Tend not to be bothered by deer
- Deer-proof: Typically, deer completely ignore it

WATER-WISE: Indicates plants require less than average watering. *Water needs are based on established plants.*

- Low-water / Water-wise: Require watering no more than 1x/week, maybe 1x/2-3 weeks
- Drought-tolerant: Plants need a good, deep soaking only 2-3x in a growing season

* ATTENTION FLORAL STAFF *

Potted plants can dry out quickly, so need regular watering. Check soil daily. Water when dry to the touch.
