

LAVTA's COVID-19 Response & Action Plan

- Daily cleaning and disinfecting regime
 - Hospital grade disinfectant at transit centers and on-board buses.
- Personal protective equipment and supplies
 - Employees/Operators offered hand sanitizer/gloves/face coverings
 - Face coverings provided for riders
- Education and outreach
 - CDC guidance and tips posted on buses/facilities
- Bus Operator protection
 - Fare free and rear boarding for riders



LAVTA's COVID-19 Response & Action Plan, Cont.

- Maintaining CDC guidance of 6 feet
 - Signage on buses promotes social distancing
- Closely monitoring of demand
- Improving passenger technology
 - Bus loads available for riders in real time
- Alternative service delivery options
 - Go Tri-Valley implemented on May 1st
