

Bus Riding Basics

For Fall 2021 Return to School

Parents and students - you can help us ensure the safe and timely operation of our services as Tri-Valley schools reopen by following these basic conduct rules on Wheels and Rapid buses.



Arrive at your stop a few minutes early. Stops are marked with signs or red "Bus Stop" stencils on curbs. Wait near the bus stop away from the street.



Have exact cash fare, monthly pass, or Clipper card ready each time before you board. Note that our Discount Youth Fare is available **only** with a Youth Clipper Card.



You can now add your Youth Clipper card to your mobile wallet by downloading the Clipper app. Then just tap your phone on the Clipper reader when you board the bus.



Federal law still requires that face masks covering the mouth and nose must be worn by all passengers riding on Wheels and Rapid buses.



Use headphones or earbuds with video and audio devices.



Only pull the bus stop pull cord if you are exiting at the next designated stop. Unnecessary stops make everyone late.

Please be aware that Wheels and Rapid buses are equipped with multiple cameras that have video and audio recording capability.

Misconduct may result in disciplinary action by your school and /or loss of riding privileges.
